Florida's Turnpike Enterprise will implement All-Electronic Tolling (AET)

– Cash Will No Longer Be Accepted on Florida's Turnpike Mainline –

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (FTE) is completing the conversion to electronic toll collection along Florida's Turnpike (SR 91). This means cash will no longer be accepted as a form of toll payment on Florida's Turnpike Mainline. Tolls will be collected electronically using a SunPass or other Florida-accepted transponder.

The conversion project includes demolishing the existing Lantana and Three Lakes mainline toll plazas, and the interchange toll ramps at the following locations: Lake Worth Rd, Southern Blvd, N. Jog Rd, Okeechobee Blvd, Beeline Hwy, PGA Blvd, Indiantown Rd, Martin Downs Blvd, Becker Rd, Port St. Lucie Blvd, Okeechobee Rd, and Yeehaw Junction.

This project will construct new free-flow AET mainline toll gantries at the following locations:

- Lantana
- Forest Hill Boulevard
- Belvedere Road
- 45 Street
- Palm Beach Gardens
- Jupiter
- Stuart
- Becker Road
- Port St. Lucie
- Midway Road
- Ft. Pierce
- Three Lakes

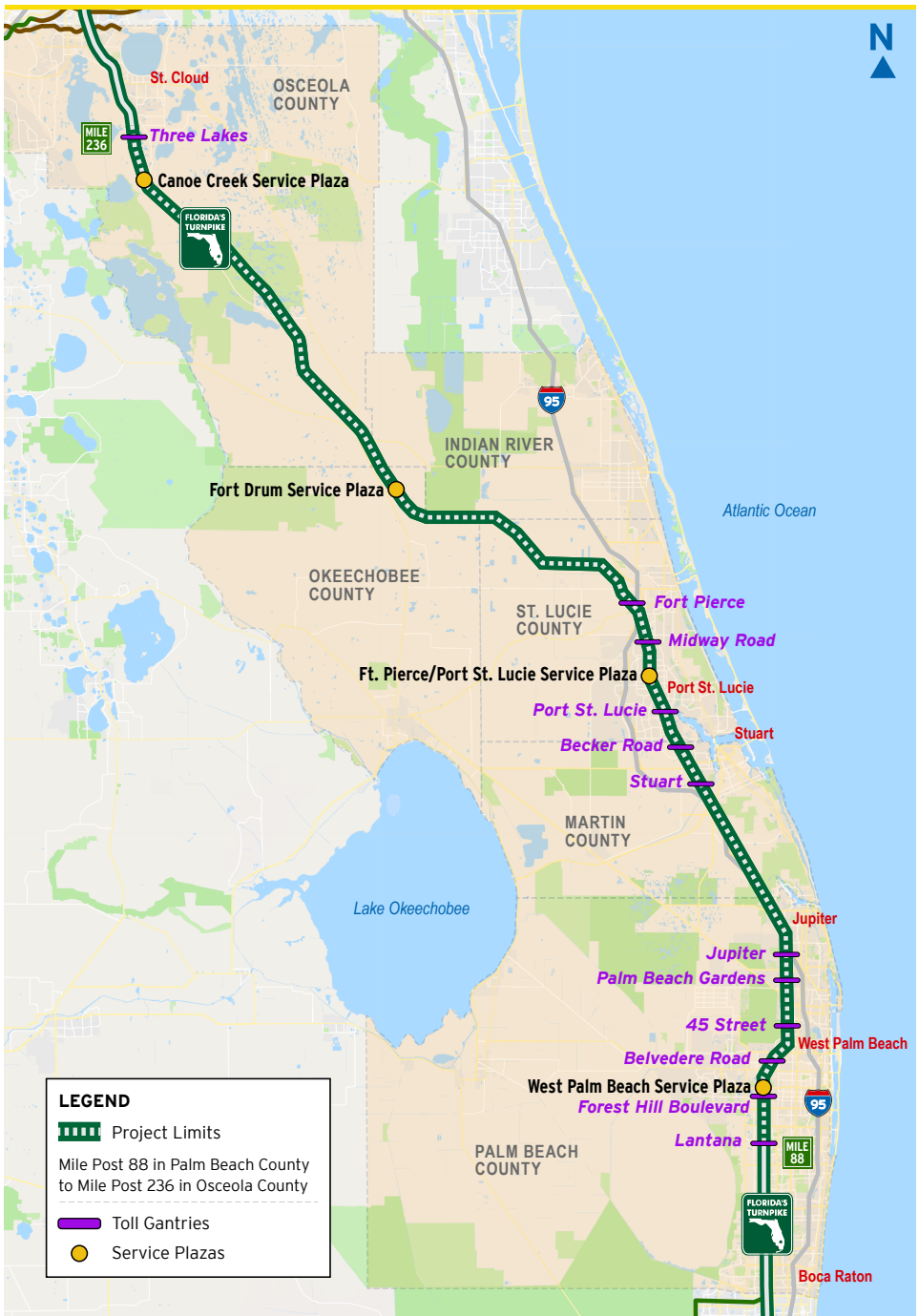
